


A Parcel for Lek and Luca





"It's so far away from Britain."






Lek thought about it and imagined a strange winged horse flying through the sky with a parcel in its mouth.

"Aunty Min drives a car, so first she must deliver the parcel to the post office in Thailand."






"Next it must be sorted and sent to the airport, and put on a plane," Luca continued.

"No way, that's far too slow," replied Luca.






"Once it arrives in Britain it can be loaded on to a lorry and sent to our local post office," Luca said.

"Then a post person can deliver it to our house on a bicycle or in a van," Lek replied.






A few days later there was a knock at the door. The post person had arrived with the parcel from Aunty Min.
