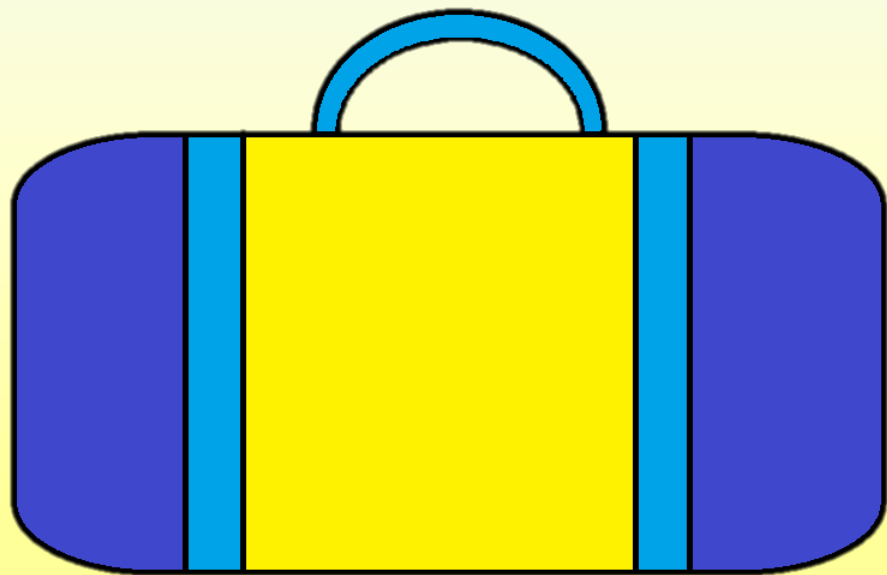
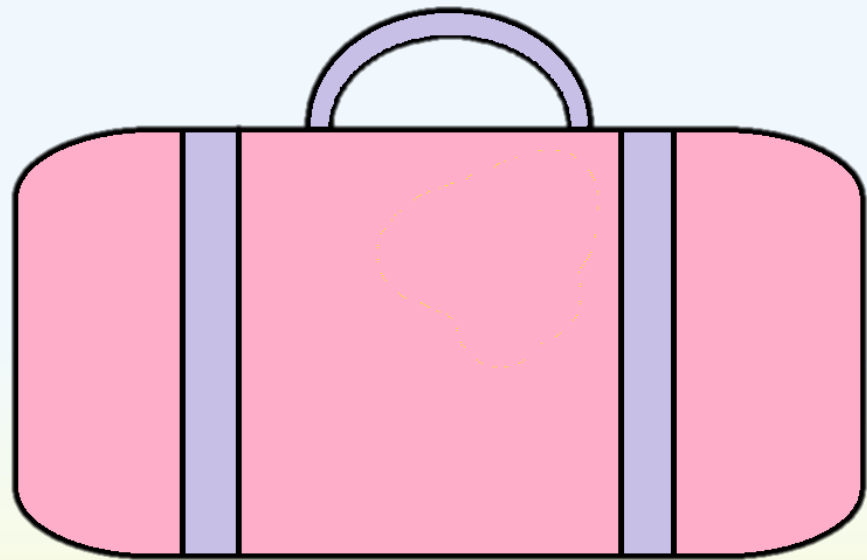
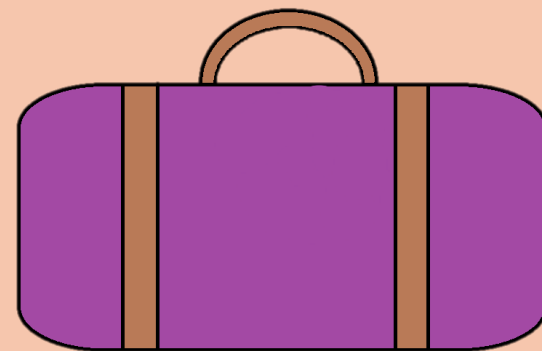




Suitcase Scramble



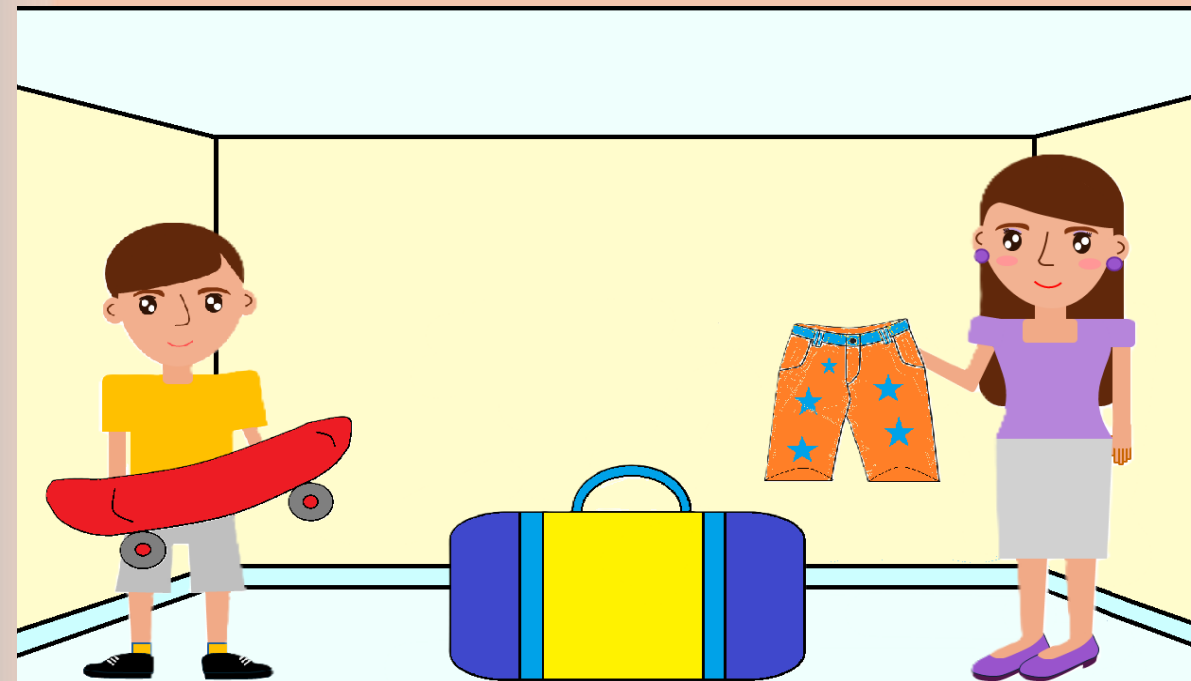

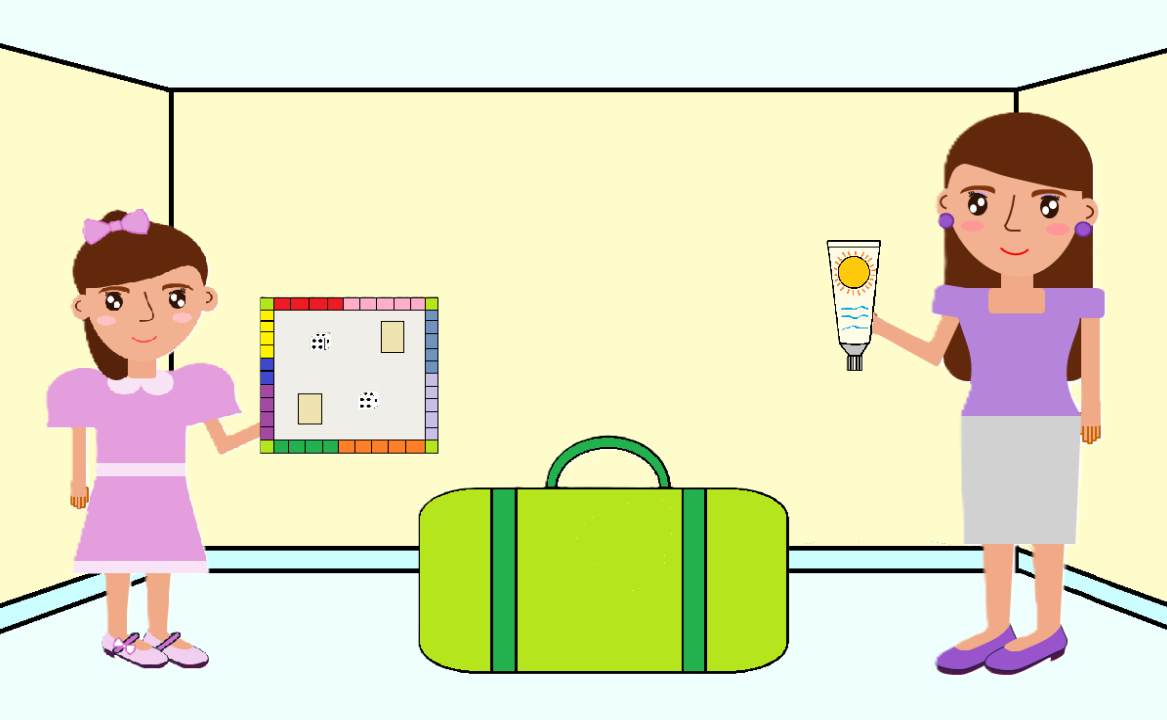


Lek and Luca were getting ready for a summer holiday on the beach, and the whole family was busy packing their suitcases.

"That won't fit in your suitcase, leave your football here please, and pack your swimwear instead," said Mum.





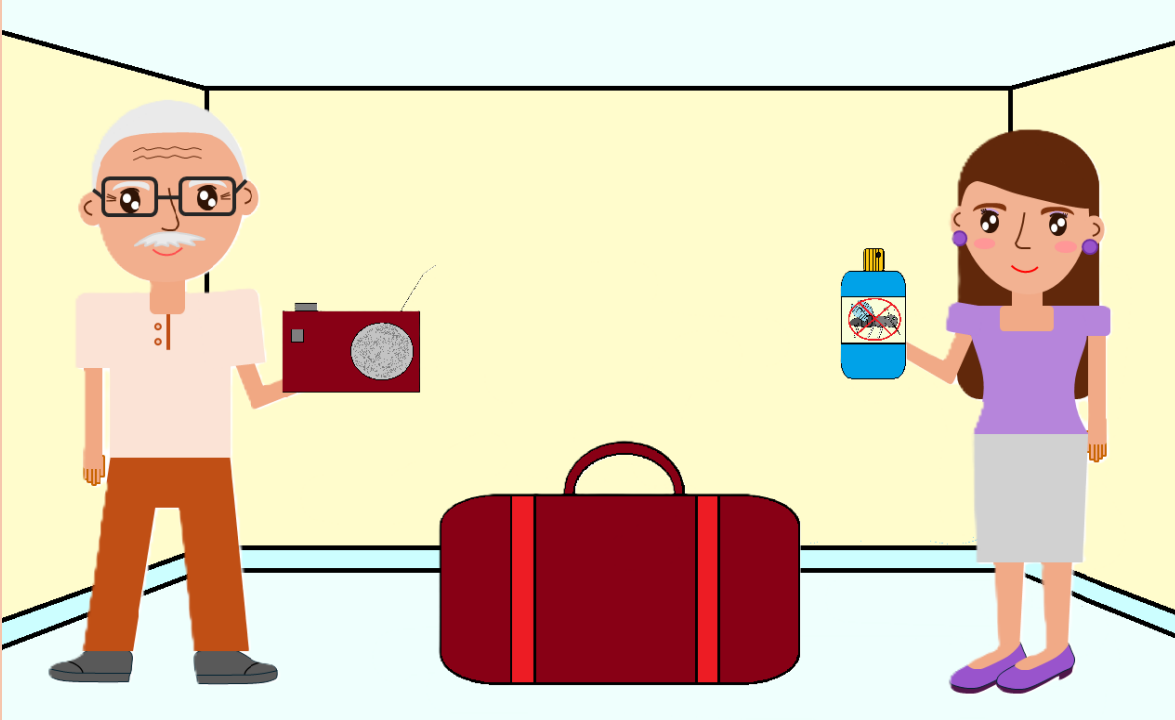
Dad wanted to pack a scarf in his suitcase.

"You won't need that on the beach, leave your board game here please, and pack some sunscreen instead," said Mum.



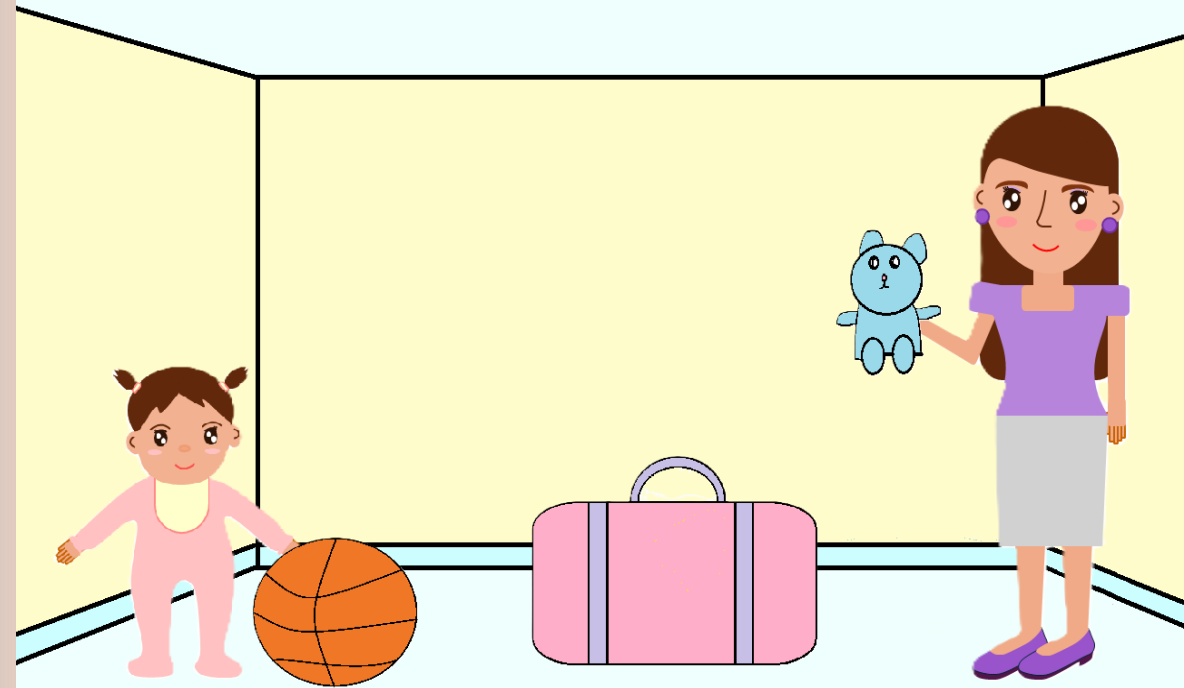


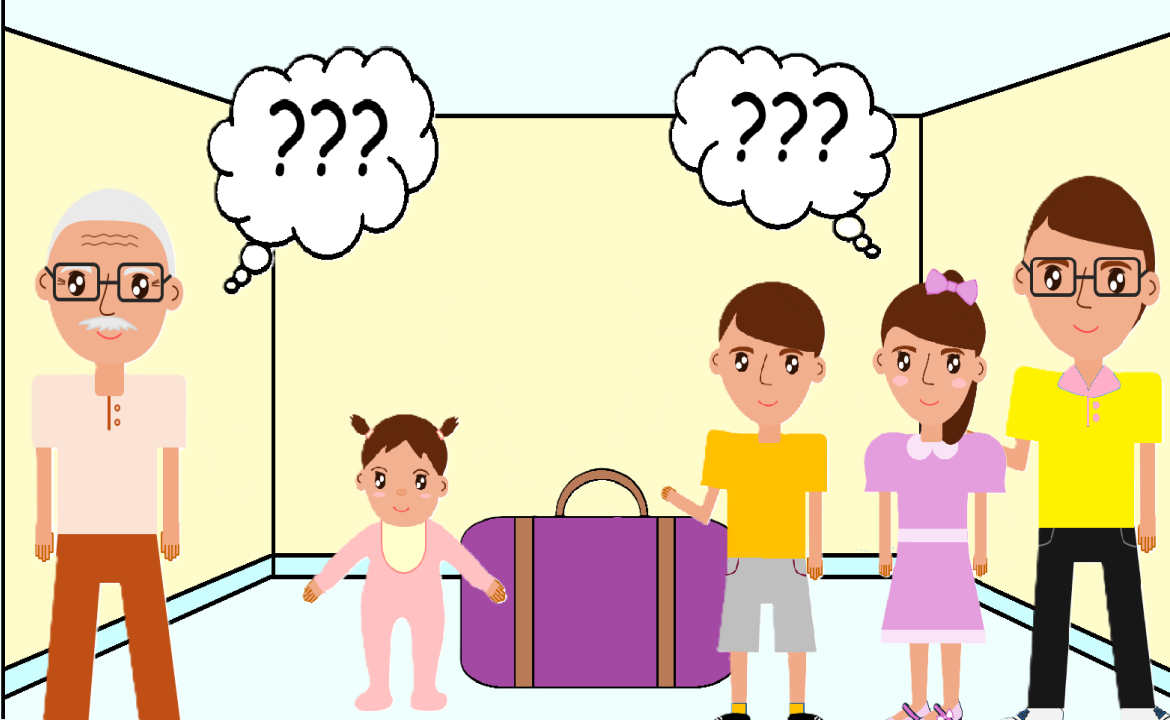
Grandpa wanted to pack a radio in his suitcase.

Baby wanted to pack a ball into her suitcase.

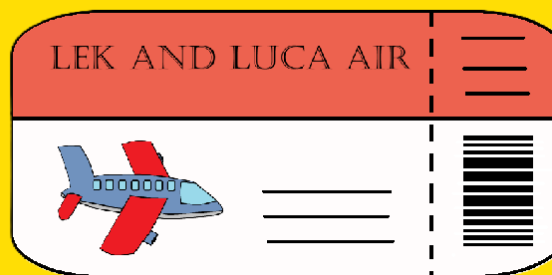
"That ball is too big for your small suitcase, leave your ball here please, and pack your teddy bear instead," said Mum.

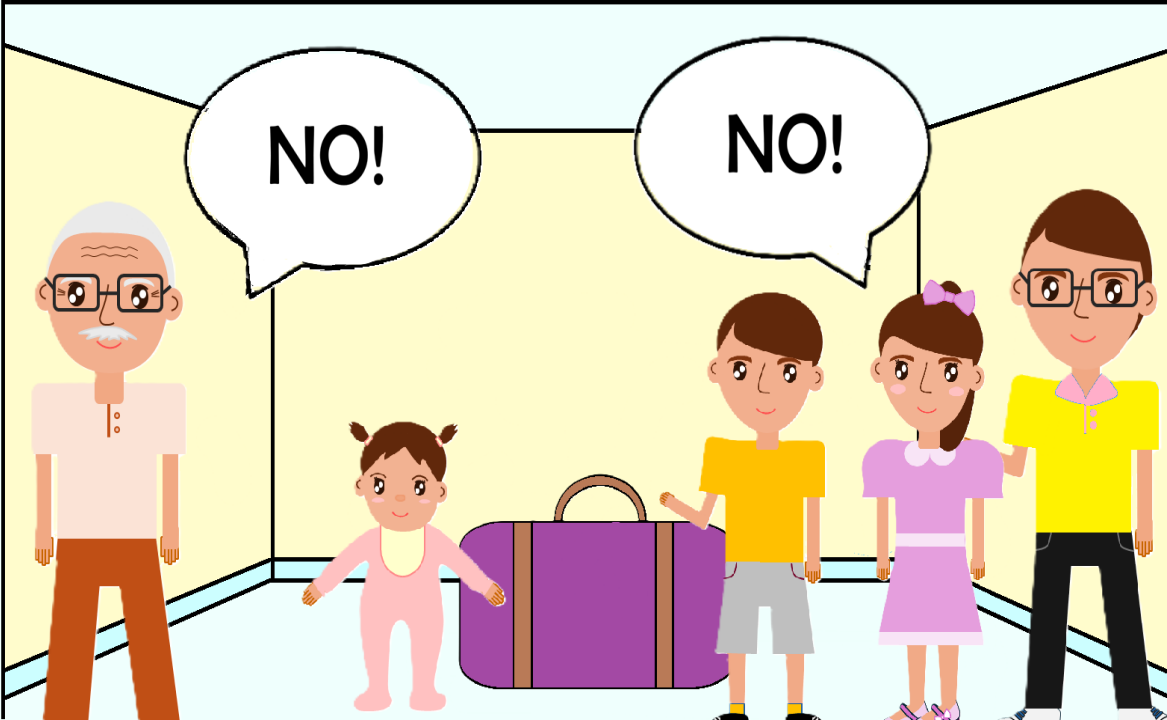




Everyone wanted to know what Mum had in her suitcase.
