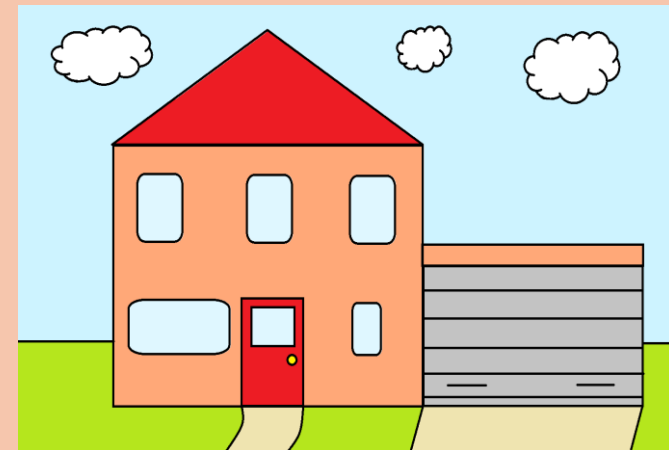
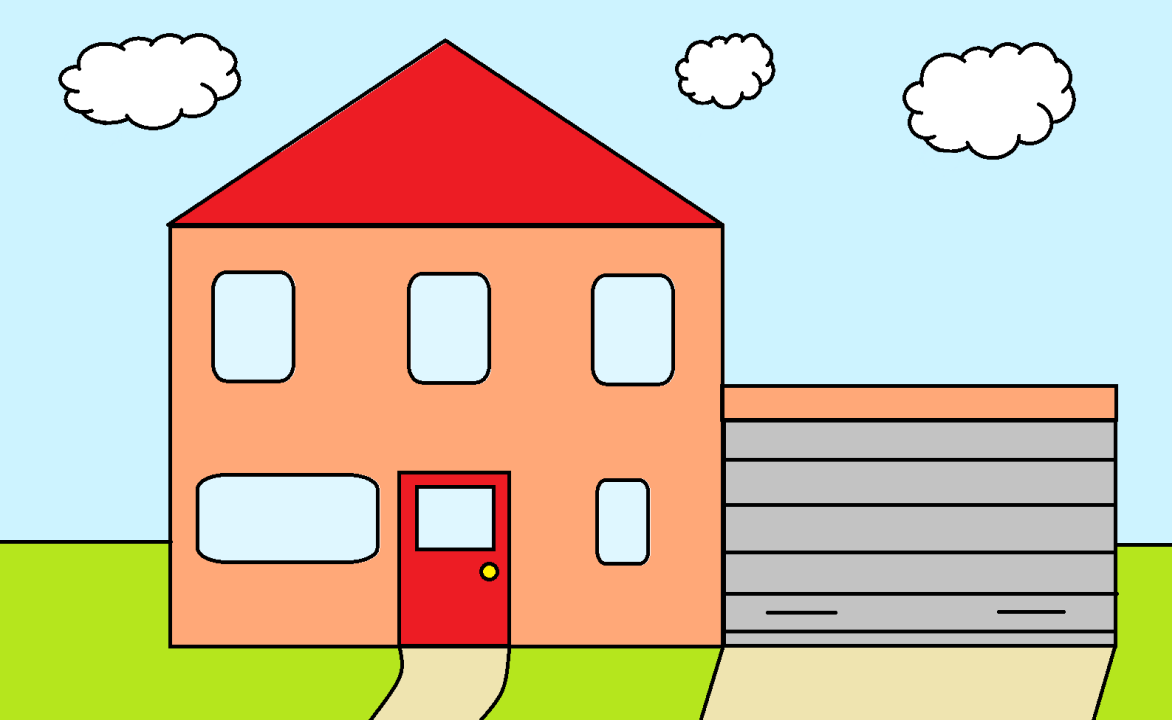


# Lek and Luca Move House

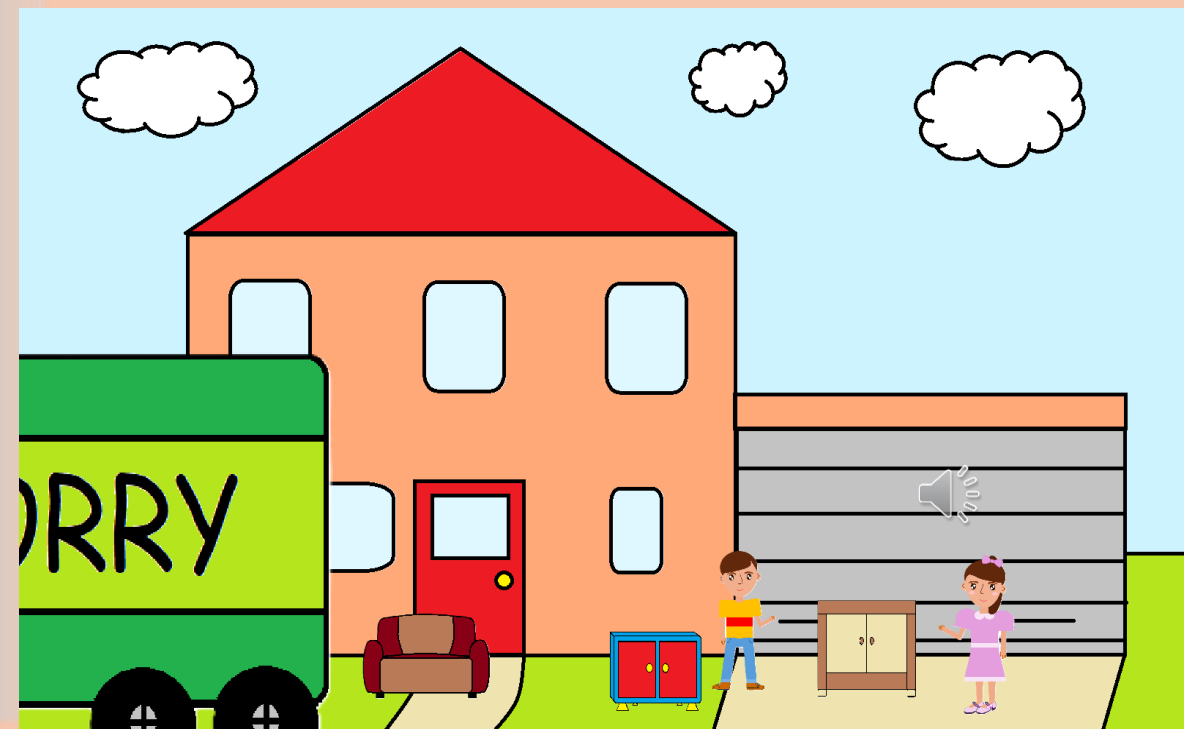

“Oh no” Luca groaned. “What are we going to do now? This means no internet or television.”

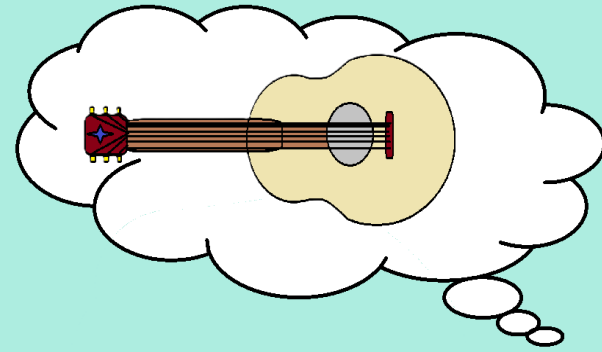
Mum found some candles in a box so at least they had some light. Now everyone had to think about what to do.

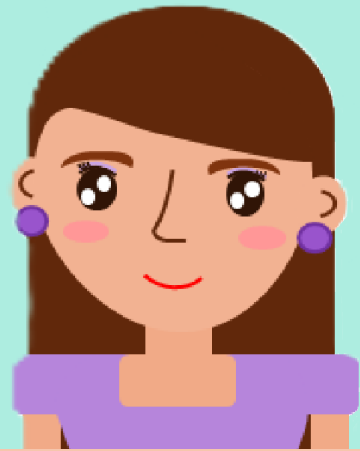
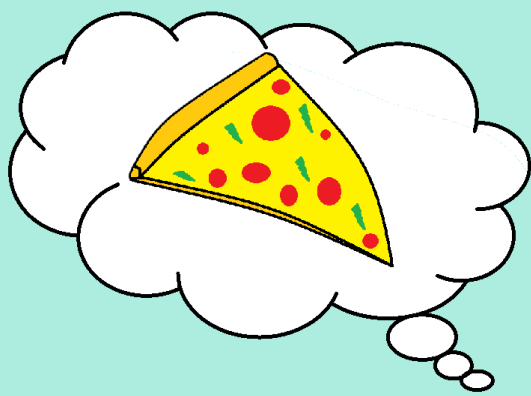




Lek thought about reading a book, but she was worried she wouldn't be able to see properly unless she sat really close to a candle, and that wasn't safe.

Dad thought about playing his guitar, but let's be honest, nobody wanted to listen to that...

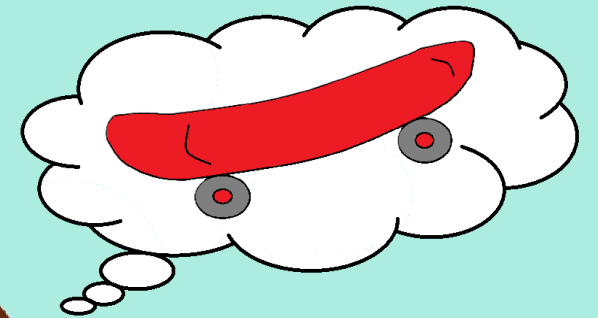


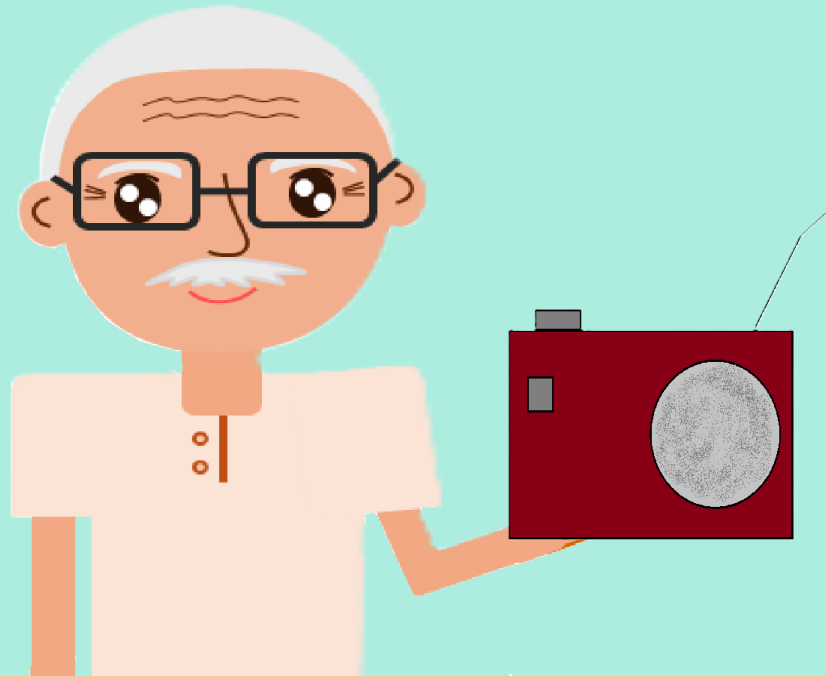


Mum had planned to bake some food in the oven but that wasn't possible now.

Luca thought about using his skateboard, but Mum said it was much too dangerous to ride a skateboard indoors.



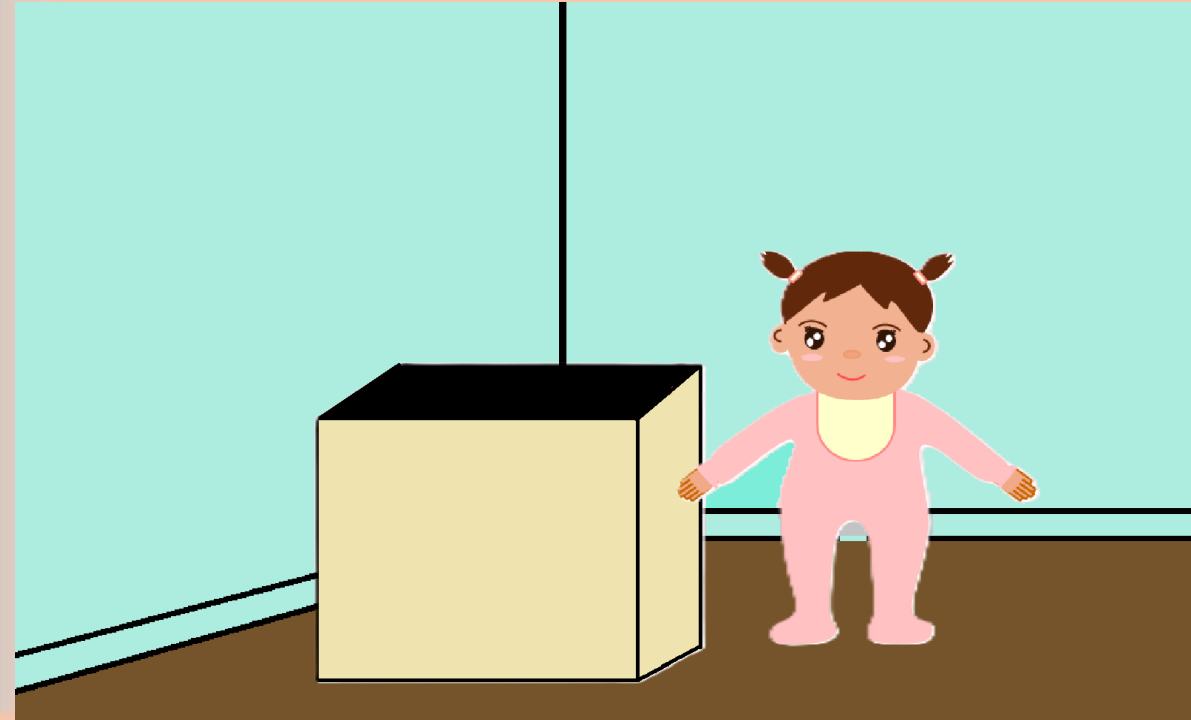


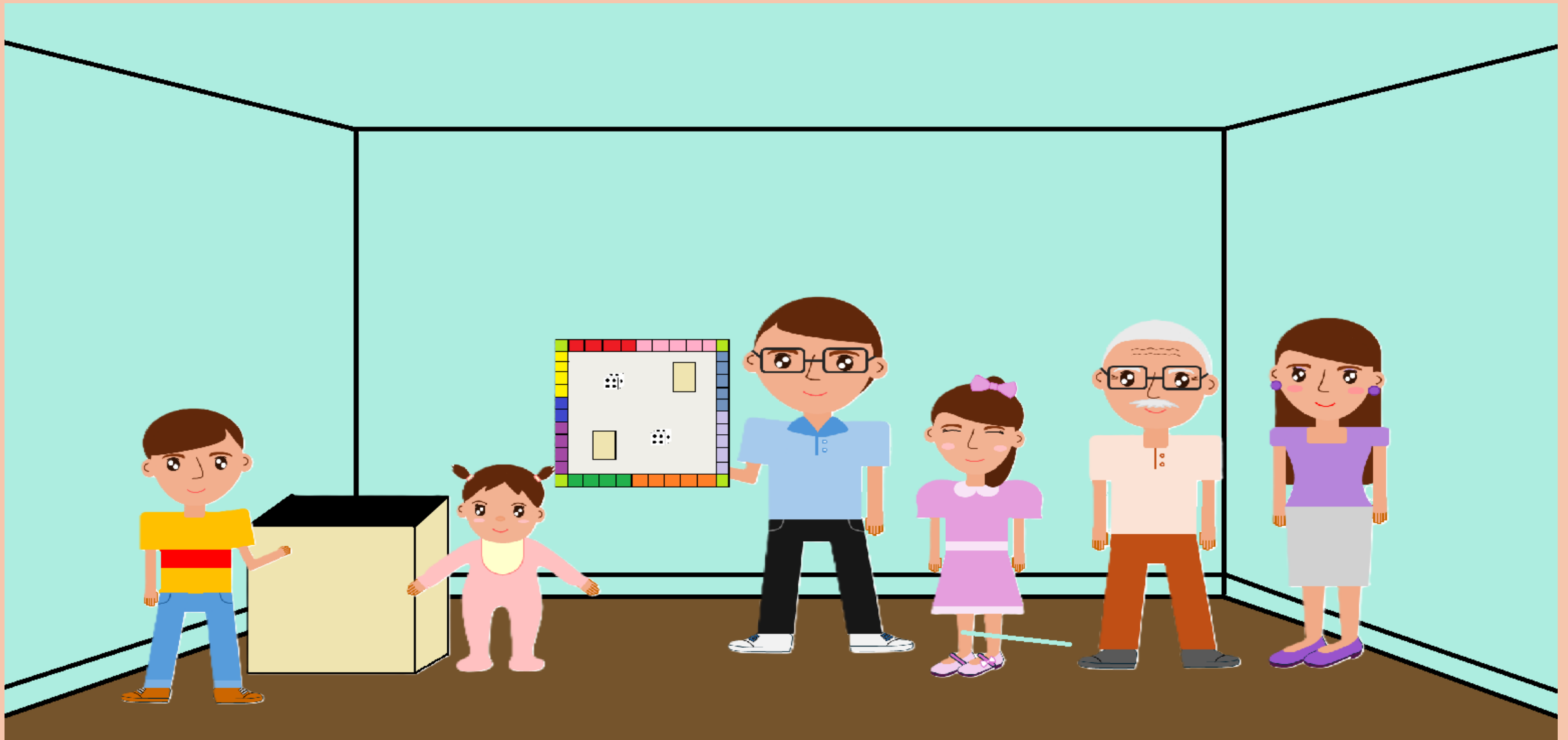
Baby was looking in a box.
