

New Socks for Dad



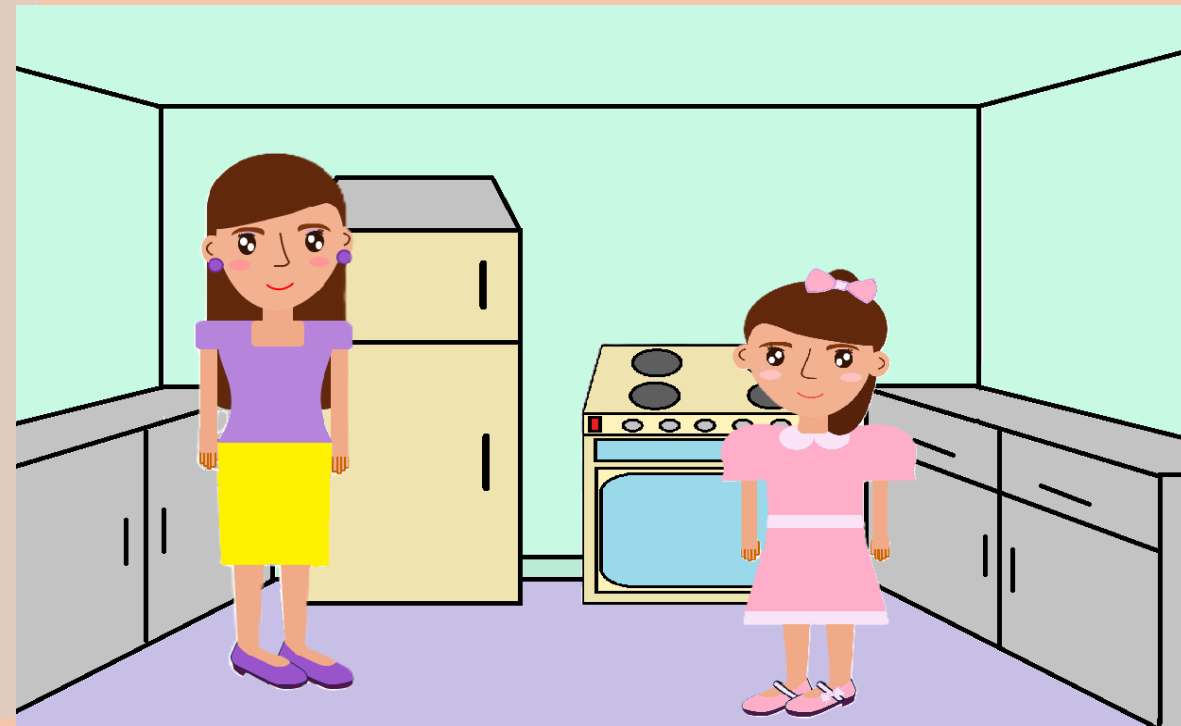

"That's a great idea," Lek replied.



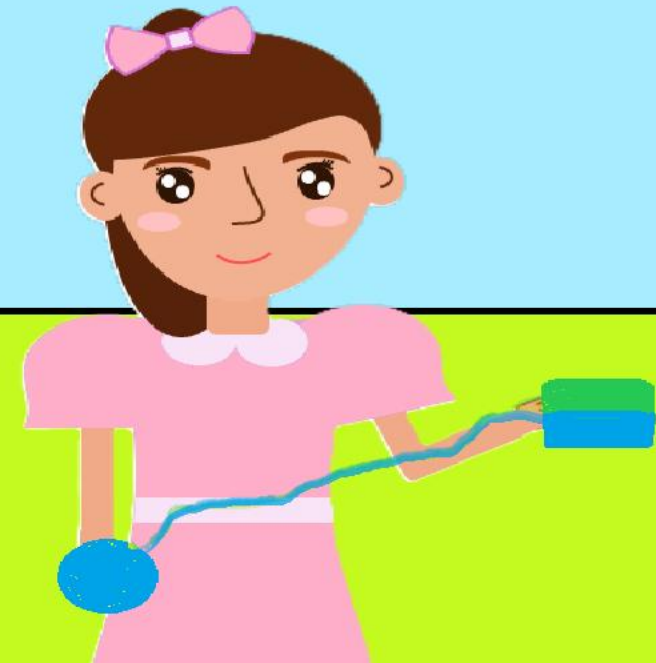


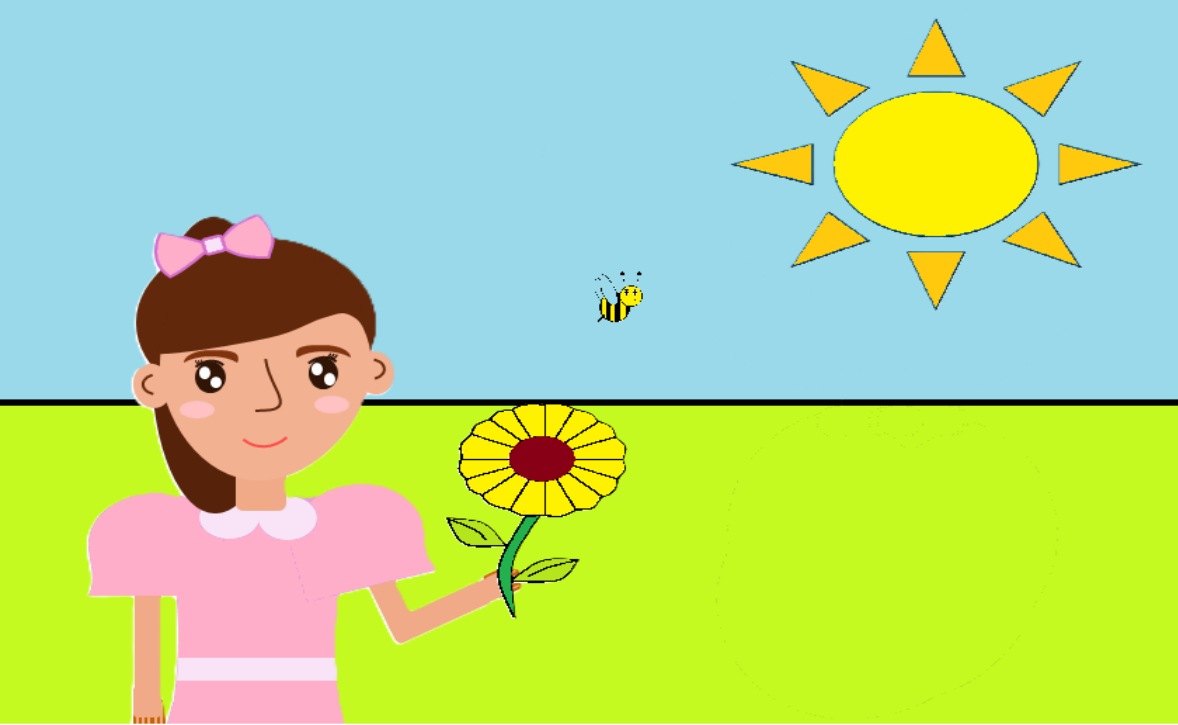
Lek looked outside in the garden.

The blue sky is so pretty she thought, and so she continued to knit the socks with blue yarn.



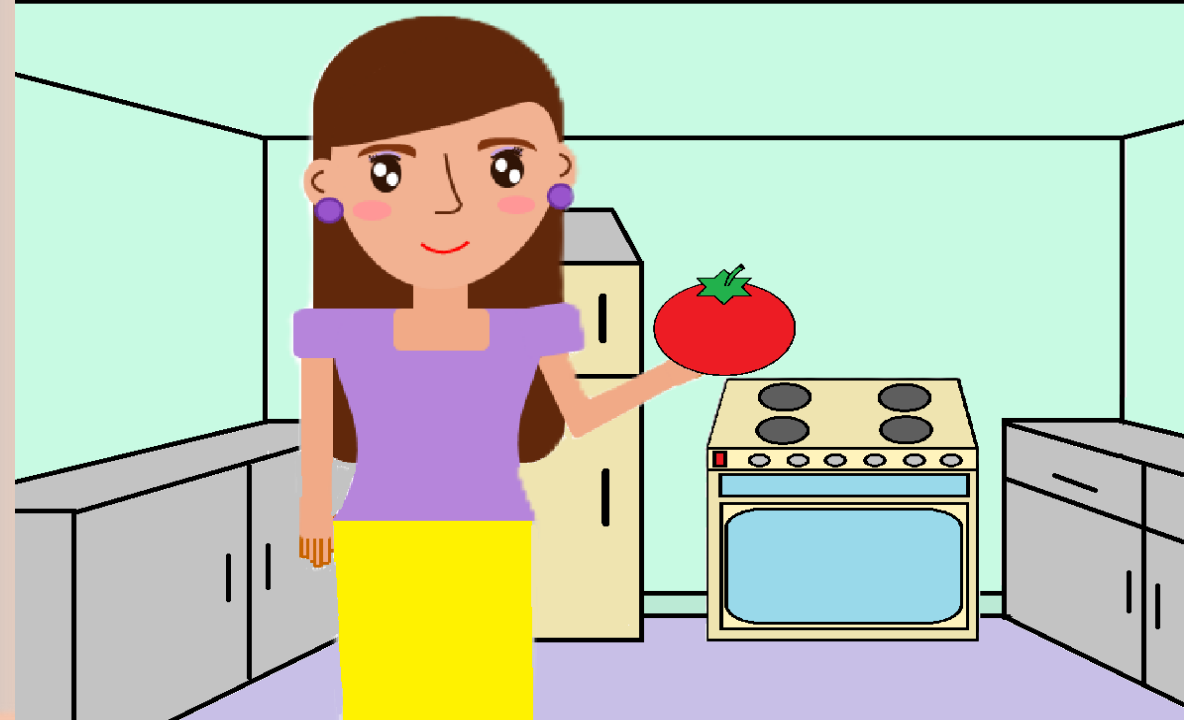


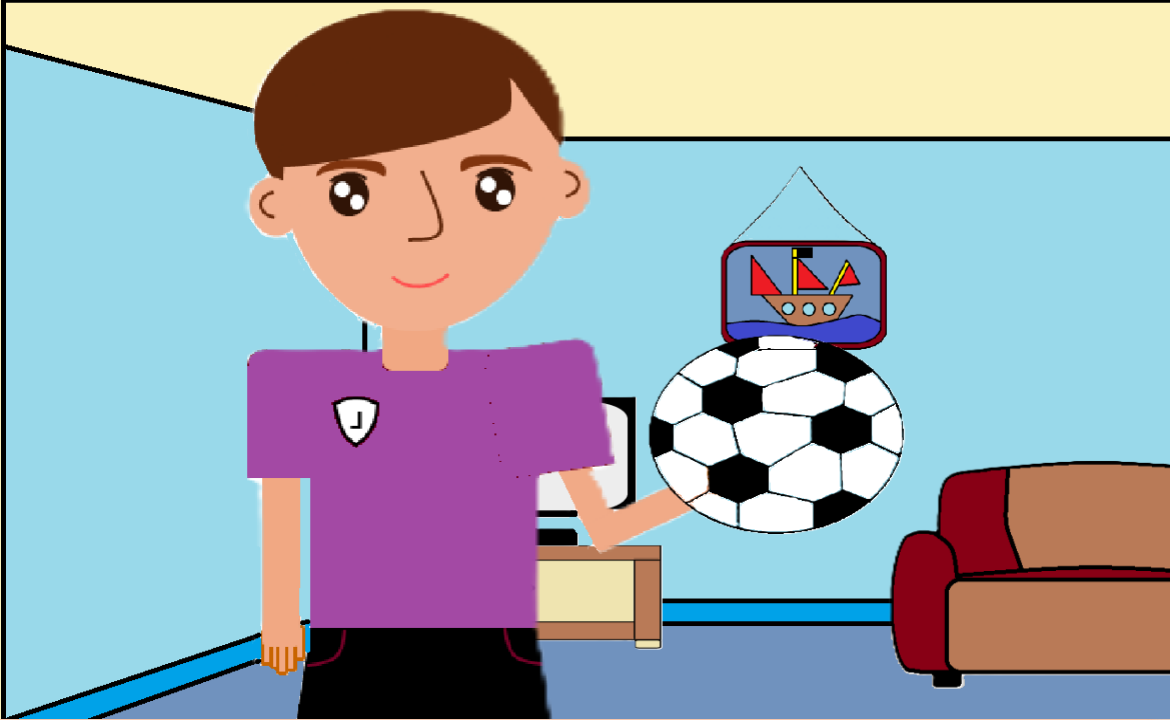
It began to get cold, so Lek went indoors. Mum was making a salad with bright red tomatoes.
